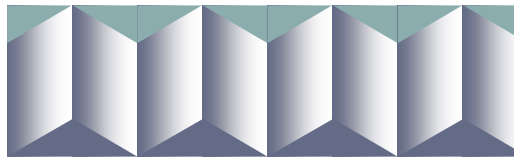
We have adopted the same original purposes as our parent body:
